PILAS also welcomes papers that engage with the conference’s main theme, “Legacies of the Past, Challenges of the Present: Inequality and Marginality in Latin America”. This theme encourages postgraduate researchers to consider some of the most pressing issues facing Latin America today. Encompassing the central problem of social and economic inequality, the conference seeks to extend the theme across disciplinary boundaries and explore its broader implications. How have attempts to combat inequality shaped the Latin American political landscape? How have marginalised groups been represented, both politically and culturally? And how has inequality affected Latin America’s relationship with the outside world? The conference aims to open these questions to wide exploration in relation to the past, present and future of the region.

We welcome papers from across the disciplines, as we wish to attract as many perspectives on Latin America as possible.
